RE: GCRC Face Mask Requirements for Indoor Settings

Effective Thursday, September 2, 2021, all Genesee County Road Commission (GCRC) employees and visitors must wear a proper face mask indoors in all GCRC buildings and garages regardless of vaccination status. This requirement also includes shared spaces such as; hallways, bathrooms, conference rooms, breakrooms, and elevators. Masks may be removed at your desk or workspace.

According to the Genesee County Health Department (GCHD), Genesee County is experiencing a recent increase in COVID-19 cases and an increasing number of highly transmissible variants, such as Delta. Therefore, GCRC is following these recommendations of GCHD until further notice.

In addition, GCRC employees are encouraged to be cooperative and practice the following:

- Social distancing whenever possible
- Washing hands frequently and using hand sanitizer when soap and water are not available
- Wear the face mask properly; covering your nose and mouth

Face masks are available and will be provided to all employees and visitors upon request.

GCHD continues to encourage all eligible persons to receive the COVID-19 vaccine. With the COVID-19 vaccine, you are reducing the risk of developing the illness and its consequences. Getting vaccinated is the most effective method available to protect people around you. If you are protected from getting infected and from disease, you are less likely to infect someone else.
