**MECHANIC**

The Genesee County Road Commission is accepting applications for a Mechanic to perform diagnosis and repair of vehicles and equipment that is normally associated with the construction and maintenance of roads, right-of-way and roadside parks. The scope of repair work is wide ranging from small engines such as chainsaws to very large engines such as tractor diesels. Will rebuild and repair the main components of vehicles including transmissions, differentials, transfer cases, clutches, drive shafts, hydraulic components, cylinders, valves, pumps, braking systems, ignition systems and tire repair. May install new items such as plows, sanders and underbody scrapers. Will operate equipment familiar to a machine shop such as drill presses, band saws, lathes and milling machines that are used in the repair and fabrication of heavy equipment. Service calls in the field may be required. Pay range is \$19.18 - \$27.06/hr. High School Diploma/GED and a Valid Michigan Driver's License are required. The following State Certifications are preferred: Automobiles and Light Trucks – Engine Repair, Front End, Suspension and Steering Systems, Brakes and Braking Systems, Electrical Systems, Heating and Air Conditioning, Engine Tune-Up/Performance. Heavy-Duty Trucks – Engine Repair – Diesel, Drive Train, Brakes and Braking Systems, Suspension and Steering Systems, Electrical Systems. Class A CDL with "N" endorsement preferred.
