REMARKS:

Unless construction operations and pole installations are performed under provisions of an approved performance agreement, a performance deposit may be required to assure highway restoration and/or protection. The amount of that deposit will be determined during review and may be equal to the estimated cost of the proposed work in the Right of Way plus restoration costs.

Performance Deposits shall be Cash, Irrevocable Letter of Credit, or Performance Bond and will be held in force a minimum of 1 year following completion of work

Lineal measurements shall be based on engineering plans, diagrams or other approved documentation furnished with the permit application for those portions of the installation within the highway right-of-way under the jurisdiction of the Genesee County Road Commission.

Permit fees, performance deposits and similar charges must be paid before the permit is issued, unless other acceptable arrangements are made at the time of issuance. For example, work performed under a blanket permit will in general be billed on a monthly basis. Permits requiring inspection reimbursement may have an escrow account established to draft inspection expenses from.

Governmental agencies, although not required to pay a permit fee, may in some instances be required to file a performance deposit.
