I-69 Ramp Closures starting August 21st

MDOT has concrete pavement repairs starting on August 21st along some ramps on I-69. The repairs will be on various ramps at Center Road, Belsay Road, Irish Road and M-15. As ramps are completed and opened other ramps at these interchanges will be closed for repairs. MDOT will also have right lanes (slow lane) closed near some of the ramps to complete pavement repairs in the right lanes.

MDOT is anticipating 3 to 5 days for the work to be completed and the concrete to cure enough to hold traffic. Detour signs will not be set up for each closure and detour. Below is a list of the ramps that will be closing Monday, August 21st.

- At Center Road.

The ramp from northbound Center Road to eastbound I-69. Detour will be to take the ramp to westbound Center Road to Dort Highway and come back on eastbound I-69.

The ramp from westbound I-69 to Center Road will be closed. Detour will be to stay on I-69 to Dort Highway exit at Dort Highway and get back on to eastbound I-69 and take the Center Road exit.

- Belsay Road

All ramps open.

- Irish Road

The ramp from westbound I-69 to Irish Road will be closed. Detour will be to stay on I-69 to Belsay Road, exit at Belsay Road and get back on to eastbound I-69 and take the Irish Road exit.

The ramp from southbound Irish Road to eastbound I-69 will be closed. Detour will be to take I-69 westbound to Belsay Road and come back on eastbound I-69.

- M-15 State Road.

The ramp from eastbound I-69 to M-15 will be closed. Detour will be to stay on I-69 to Elba Road, exit at Elba Road and get back on to eastbound I-69 and take the M-15 exit.
