SUMMER MECHANIC INTERNSHIP

The Genesee County Road Commission (GCRC), Flint, MI, is pleased to announce its paid Mechanics Internship Program and invite interested applicants to apply. Resumes are being accepted for a Mechanic Intern position from May to September. Under the direction of the Fleet Maintenance Supervisor, the Mechanic Intern will be required to perform a range of duties and responsibilities that can differ daily depending on the jobs that the supervisor assigns. The jobs may include but are not limited to routine maintenance work, minor repair work, or specialized repairs. As the mechanic intern, you will work alone or assist our experienced mechanics to learn repair techniques and operate machinery and tools to repair components.

Ideal applicants are individuals pursuing a degree or certificate or have recently completed an auto mechanics program from a college or technical school and are interested in gaining hands-on automotive and diesel services work experience.

Applicants should possess good problem-solving and troubleshooting skills, be able to operate machinery and tools with good hand/eye coordination, have a strong understanding of mechanics, and be attentive to detail. They should also have practical knowledge of vehicle diagnostic equipment. They should perform duties that require physical fitness and stamina to stoop, crawl, work while lying down, and lift heavy machinery. Applicants must be able to receive directions and be willing to learn on the job.
