Mechanic I, II, or III {depending upon certification}

Genesee County Road Commission is accepting resumes for Mechanic I, II or III depending upon certification.

BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF DUTIES: Mechanic I

Under the supervision of a Fleet Maintenance Supervisor, works as a mechanic capable of performing at least one type of repair operation on Commission vehicles, equipment or buildings. This is an entry-level position in the Fleet Maintenance & Facilities Department. Employees occupying this classification generally work under the guidance of a Mechanic II.

BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF DUTIES: Mechanic II

Under the supervision of a Fleet Maintenance Supervisor, works as a mechanic repairing or replacing parts and making mechanical adjustments on a wide range of motors and mechanical equipment which includes welding, wiring, hydraulic and installation of special equipment to maintain all the equipment used by Commission personnel to construct and maintain the county's roads and right-of-way and/or garage equipment and buildings. This position is part of the natural promotional progression from the Mechanic I classification within the Fleet Maintenance & Facilities Department.

BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF DUTIES: Mechanic III

Under the supervision of a Fleet Maintenance Supervisor, employees in this classification have the ability to perform all of the requirements of a Mechanic I and a Mechanic II. They must maintain all the certifications, licenses and endorsements of Mechanic I and a Mechanic II. They shall have the ability to diagnose, maintain, and repair all heavy-duty trucks, specialized equipment and light automobiles/trucks. They must be a certified Master Automotive Mechanic and Certified Master Heavy-duty Truck Mechanic. Any Mechanic will be classified as a Mechanic III when he acquires or possesses and maintains State Certifications.

MINIMUM HIRING REQUIREMENTS:

High School Diploma/GED and a Valid Michigan Driver's License. Employees in this classification must maintain a valid Class "A" Michigan driver's license with "N" endorsement. Level of Mechanic is determined by State of Michigan Certification.
