<u>Genesee County Road Commission Employee Handbook</u> – In a memorandum dated October 30, 2019, staff requested the Board approve the 2019 revised GCRC Employee Handbook and adoption of the resolution. (Copy of memorandum and resolution filed with official minutes.)

Commissioner Kautman-Jones asked if the handbook covered random drug and alcohol testing for all employees, not just those with CDL licenses. Human Resource Director Donna Poplar stated that this is covered under managerial rights. The Board and Managing Director Peivandi thanked Human Resource Administrative Assistant, Ms. Monica Pearson for her help with the employee handbook.

Limestone Resurfacing (2019 Project) - Consumers Energy Saginaw Trail Pipeline Project, Frances Road from Vassar Road to Irish Road, Forest Township – In a memorandum dated October 31, 2019, staff requested the Board approve the Limestone Resurfacing project on Frances Road from Vassar Road to Irish Road in Forest Township due to the Consumers Energy Saginaw Trail Pipeline project construction. (Copy of memorandum and Stoneco limestone delivery invoices filed with official minutes.)

All overpayments will be reimbursed back to Consumers Energy.

MANAGING DIRECTOR REPORT

<u>Argentine Township Dam Repairs</u> – Director of Engineering, Mr. Eric Johnston explained that on November 01, 2019, the Argentine Township dam was opened in the morning to accommodate excessive water levels due to heavy rainfall. When the operator went to close the gates that evening, one of the primary gates would not go down. The operator called 911 and they got in contact with GCRC Programming and Development Engineer, Mr. Alexander Patsy, P.E. Mr. Patsy contacted Zito Construction to help repair the door mechanism on the gate. Because the gate controls the water level of the lake, Mr. Johnston stated that the Lobdell Lake level was descending by 4.5 inches of water per day that the gate remained open. Mr. Johnston said Genesee County Road Commission and Zito Construction would be working on the gate mechanism today to try to get the gate closed. Managing Director, Mr. Peivandi stated that there was an old agreement written in the early 1920's with Argentine Township that the Township is the owner of the dam and the GCRC is the maintaining agency of the dam. Mr. Peivandi stated he would be meeting with Argentine Township to discuss the maintenance responsibility to see if the Township can generate revenue for the dam through a special assessment of lake owners. Mr. Peivandi indicated that since 2001, GCRC has spent \$420,000 towards the maintenance of the Argentine Dam.

Mr. Johnston stated that the Argentine Township Supervisor, Mr. Brian Saad, did talk to the MDEQ about the Argentine Dam and the MDEQ stated that there is money available through grants.

<u>Update on Winter Maintenance Operations</u> – Director of Operations, Mr. Randy Dellaposta updated the Board on the GCRC Winter Maintenance Operations. Mr. Dellaposta stated that all winter maintenance fleet vehicles have been inspected by the districts and the fleet is prepped and ready for the snowfall predicted for Monday, November 11, 2019. The Linden and Otisville district garages are up and running with 10,000-gallon brine tanks. The Flint facility has two brine tanks. Mr. Dellaposta stated that the brine mixture would result in a huge decrease in our salt usage.

Chairperson Mandelaris asked for a motion to accept the Managing Director report.

<u>Investment Policy Changes</u> - Chairperson Mandelaris commented on the investment policy changes, inquiring on the difference in color of the strike-through corrections made. Staff stated each color represented who made the changes, staff, legal counsel or the financial investment firm. Chairperson Mandelaris asked that staff insure the correct the MCL number is on the resolution
