M-54 (Dort Highway) signal upgrades in Genesee County start Feb. 10

PROJECT:

The Michigan Department of Transportation (MDOT) will invest \$643,000 in signal improvements at three intersections along the M-54 corridor in Genesee County. Work will address signal modernization needs and efficiencies at M-54/Court Street, M-54/Oklahoma Avenue/Western Road, and M-54/Leith Street.
