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Stage 4 Part II of the Bristol Road Bridge replacement begins November 14th in Flint Township Flint, Michigan. ---

The Genesee County Road Commission began replacement of Bristol Road Bridge over Call Drain, between Torrey Road and I-75, in Flint Township on Thursday, August 23, 2018. On November 14th at 7:00 a.m. the entrance ramp from westbound Bristol Road to southbound I-75 will close for concrete pavement repair. At this time westbound Bristol Road traffic needing access to southbound I-75 will be detoured to the eastbound I-69 entrance ramp and then southbound I-75. Traffic on Bristol Road will be maintained with at least one lane in each direction of travel. The entrance and exit ramps from eastbound Bristol Road to southbound I-75 will open on November 14th prior to the ramp closure noted above.

The anticipated open to traffic date for the entrance ramp from westbound Bristol Road to southbound I-75 is November 26, 2018. Full completion of the entire project has been pushed back slightly to December 14, 2018 due to inclement weather.
